DEVOTIONAL

OCTOBER 14 - 24

Day 1 | October 14

Verse: John 6:35 - "Jesus declared, 'I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to Me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in Me will never be thirsty.'"

Question: How can I see Jesus as the Bread of Life through today's fasting?

Prayer: God, today I am putting my trust in You to be the One who nourishes my soul. Help me to truly recognize You as the Bread of Life. Increase my hunger for You. Fulfill my needs and lead my way as only You can.

Day 2 | October 15

Verse: Jeremiah 29: 12 - 13: "Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

Question: When and where can you pause today to demonstrate to God that you are seeking Him with all your heart?

Prayer: Lord, today I come calling upon you and praying to you, asking you to lead me and my church community in knowing you in greater ways as we fast.

Day 3 | October 16

Verse: Psalm 63:1, "You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water."

Question: As you fast today, what can you do to demonstrate to God that your heart earnestly seeks Him?

Prayer: Lord, today I desire to thirst for you more, long to hear your voice more, and be satisfied in my soul by your presence to greater depths than ever before.

Day 4 | October 17

Verse: Psalm 42: 1 - 2, "As the deer longs for streams of water, so I long for you, O God. I thirst for God, the living God. When can I go and stand before him?"

Question: Where can you go today and stand before the Lord to worship Him?

Prayer: Lord, as I fast today, may my soul be flooded with your presence, and I experience you as my living God.

Day 5 | October 18

Verse: John 7:37 - 38, "On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, 'Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, 'Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.'"

Question: How wide and deep is God's river of living waters flowing within your heart?

Prayer: Lord Jesus, as I fast today, shout to my soul and increase your living waters that flow within my heart.

Day 6 | October 19

Verse: Matthew 5:6, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."

Question: Do you desire the blessing of Matthew 5:6?

Prayer: Lord, as I hunger and thirst today, I do so seeking you and your ways. Bless me and fill me with your righteousness.

Day 7 | October 20

Verse: Isaiah 55: 9, "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

Question: As I go about this day, how can I further align my ways and thoughts with the Lord's ways and thoughts?

Prayer: Lord, as I fast, speak to my soul and my mind. Place your thoughts in mine and guide me to replace my ways with yours.

Day 8 | October 21

Verse: Matthew 13:16, "But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear."

Question: Are you attentive to the presence of God and His voice as you go about your day?

Prayer: Lord, as I fast, help me to see you and hear your voice in ever-increasing ways. Help me to see as you see. Help me to hear what you are saying to me.

Day 9 | October 22

Verse: Acts 17:27, "God did this so that men would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us."

Question: How near is God to you today?

Prayer: Lord, as I fast today, I reach out to you in my prayers, my posture, and my focus to know you and your nearness. Help me to find you throughout the rhythm of this day.

Day 10 | October 23

Verse: Psalm 34:8, "Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the man who takes refuge in him."

Question: What does it mean to you to "taste and see that the Lord is good"?

Prayer: Lord, as I fast today, I desire to taste and see your goodness in measures that refresh my whole being.
